Literacy

Numeracy

Work out in our head what one more, one less than a number would be.
Count, recognise and order numbers to 20 and beyond.
Create and continue a pattern.

Understanding the World

Talk about differences in habitats.
Learn about Chinese New Year.
Take part in RSPB bird watch.
Learn how to log on and off school laptops and play games.



Expressive Art and Design

Explore and change the sound of instruments to make animal noises.
Construct with a purpose in mind using a variety of materials. For example making animals using junk modelling equipment.
Play co-operatively together in imaginative play.
