ATTENDANCE FIGURES

The school attendance for the week beginning 17.12.18 was 93.6%

The class attendances were as follows:

- Reception: 97%
- Year 1: 88.7%
- Year 2: 100%
- Year 3: 95.83%
- Year 4: 95.65%
- Year 5: 94.33%
- Year 6: 86.84%

Well done to Reception and Year 2 for achieving our school target of 96%.

Today we have given out 126 certificates for good attendance (96% or above) this term.

This is a fabulous achievement. Well done!
