RECEPTION OUTDOOR AREA

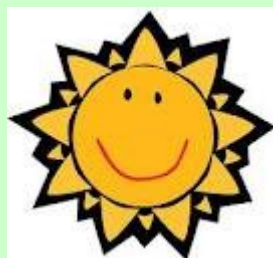
We are currently looking at the outdoor provision in our Reception class and we have some ambitious plans and we need your help.
